

Choir or Cantor	
Description of Role	To support the worship of the gathered assembly at parish liturgies through music.
	Cantor: sing the responsorial psalm and gospel acclamation and lead the congregation responses.
Time Required	Practice time at home
	Rehearsal time for major celebrations e.g. Easter and Christmas
Gifts & Talents	Ability to sing in tune
	Cantor: ability to sing alone, either accompanied or unaccompanied.
	Willingness to develop these skills (ability to read music is not necessary)
	Willingness to develop knowledge and understanding of the Mass
	Ability to work as part of a team
Support Provided	Support is given by other choir members and the leader as required
	Cantor: support of accompanist and provision of Gregorian chant music for the Sunday if needed. Practice in Gregorian chant provided.
