Gifts & Talents	Ability to use cleaning materials and equipment (e.g. vacuum cleaner) Enthusiasm and dedication.
Support Provided	You will work with a partner during the cleaning sessions and support from cleaning co-ordinator is always available if needed e.g. for help if usual partner away or to be a link for any other issues arising whilst cleaning.
