Flower Arranging	
Description of Role	Make the church look beautiful and welcoming in order to enhance the liturgies. Obtain and arrange flowers for Masses and decorate for special occasions such as funerals, baptisms, weddings, Easter and Christmas
Time Required	2-3 hours a month working on a rota. For big occasions this may take longer.
Gifts & Talents	Artistic flair and experience would be an advantage but are not necessary Willingness to learn about flower arranging Must be reliable in turning up when needed. Ability to work alone most of the time but as part of a team at Christmas Easter and for special celebrations
Support Provided	Learning by working with other experienced flower arrangers Parish will pay for flowers used.
